

Genus *Hadbjergicola*

Etymology

[had.bjer.gi'co.la] **Danish n.** *Hadbjerg*, Danish parish; **L. masc. suff.** *cola*, an inhabitant; **N.L. masc. n.** *Hadbjergicola*, Microbe named after the Danish parish of Hadbjerg, near which the genome of the type species was recovered.

Nomenclatural type

Species *Hadbjergicola scandiae*^{Ts}

Description

Genus established on the basis of phylogenomic comparisons to GTDB R226 and 16S rRNA classifications to Silva 138.2. Formerly known as genus RBG-16-49-21 in GTDB R226. The description of the genus is the same as for its type species *Hadbjergicola scandiae*.
