

## Genus *Vinderslevimen*

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### Etymology

[vin.der.sle'vi.men] **Danish n.** *Vinderslev*, Danish parish; **N.L. neut. n.** *Vinderslevimen*, Microbe arbitrarily named after the Danish parish of Vinderslev, near which the genome of the type species was recovered.

### Nomenclatural type

Species *Vinderslevimen danicum*<sup>Ts</sup>

### Description

Genus established on the basis of phylogenomic comparisons to GTDB R226 and 16S rRNA classifications to Silva 138.2. Formerly known as genus PALSA-188 in GTDB R226. The description of the genus is the same as for its type species *Vinderslevimen danicum*.
