

Genus *Ordinivivax*

Etymology

[Or.di.ni.vi'vax] **L. masc. n.** *ordo*, a regular line, row, series; **L. masc. adj.** *vivax*, tenacious to life, lively, vivacious; **N.L. masc. n.** *Ordinivivax*, a regularly arranged living organism

Nomenclatural type

Species “*Ordinivivax streblomastichis*”

Description

Treitli et al., 2019: The bacterium attaches to the surface of *S. strix* from the gut of *Z. angusticollis*. This assignment is based on the genome fragments deposited in GenBank, <https://www.ncbi.nlm.nih.gov/genbank> (SNRX000000000), as well as specific 16S rRNA gene hybridization with probe ST-BACT-81
