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### Etymology

[phos.pho.ri.vo.rans] N. L. part. adj. *phosphorivorans*, ability to accumulate poly-phosphate

### Nomenclatural type

*Candidatus* Dechloromonas phosphorivorans [phos.pho.ri.vo'.rans, from N.L. masc. n. *phosphorus*, phosphorus; L. pres. part. *vorans*, devouring; N.L. part. adj. *phosphorivorans*, indicating the ability to accumulate poly-phosphate]
