

## Species *Jordiarchaeum madagascariense*<sup>Ts</sup>

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### Etymology

[ma.da.ga.scar.i.en'se] N.L. neut. adj. *madagascariense*, of or pertaining to Madagascar, an island country in the Indian Ocean

### Nomenclatural type

### Description

Sun, et al (2021): This uncultured lineage is represented by the genome “EB\_bin\_7”, NCBI BioSample SAMN19461862, recovered from elephant bird fossils in Madagascar, with an estimated completeness of 95.02% and a contamination of 2.41%, the presence of a 23S, 16S and 5S rRNA gene and 16 tRNAs.
