[Lu.ti.vul.ca.nar.chae.a'ce.ae] **N.L. neut. n.** *Lutivulcanarchaeum*, referring to the type genus *Lutivulcanarchaeum*; *-aceae*, ending to denote a family; **N.L. fem. pl. n.** *Lutivulcanarchaeaceae*, the *Lutivulcanarchaeum* family

[Lu.ti.vul.ca.nar.chae'um] **L. neut. n.** *lutum*, mud; **L. masc. n.** *Vulcanus*, the Roman god of fire, used here to denote an origin from mud volcano; **N.L. neut. n.** *archaeum*, an archaeon; **N.L. neut. n.** *Lutivulcanarchaeum*, an archaeon from a mud volcano

Etymology

[fer.men'tans] **L. neut. part. adj.** *fermentans*, fermenting, referring to the source of genome from anaerobic digestion of organic wastes

Nomenclatural type

[Genome sc|0006257](#) ^{Ts}

Description

Not cultivated. Inferred to be an anaerobic, obligate organotroph that obtains energy through fermentation of low-molecular-weight organic substrates. Represented by the genome (JCB CDW010000000) assembled from the metagenome of a terrestrial mud volcano fluid.
