This nomenclature is proposed in recognition of the organism's distinct proficiency in executing the shikimate pathway, as elucidated by our investigations into the endosymbiont associated with <i>Oryzaephilus surinamensis</i>.</p> <p>The choice of the genus name is centered on the organism's remarkable metabolic feature—the shikimate pathway—a vital biochemical route integral to the synthesis of essential aromatic compounds. "Shikimatogenerans" encapsulates the organism's notable capacity to engage in this crucial metabolic process.</p> <p>By adopting this genus name, we aim to highlight and categorize bacteria sharing this metabolic trait, contributing to a more refined taxonomic understanding. Species <i>Shikimatogenerans silvanidophilus</i> <sup>Ts</sup>	<p>[sil.va.ni.do.phi'lus] <b>N.L. n.</b> <i>Silvanidae</i>, family of beetles from forested environments.; <b>N.L. masc. suff.</b> <i>-philus</i>, affinity or association with; <b>N.L. masc. adj.</b> <i>silvanidophilus</i>, association with or love of <i>Silvanidae</i> beetles.</p>	<p>We propose the name 'Shikimatogenerans silvanidophilus OSUR' for this endosymbiont of <i>Oryzaephilus surinamensis</i>, henceforth called <i>S. silvanidophilus</i>. The genus name <i>Shikimatogenerans</i> refers to its ability to perform the shikimate pathway. Previous studies have shown that there might be other closely related Bacteroidetes bacteria associated with other beetle families. Thus, we propose <i>silvanidophilus</i> as species name to indicate that this symbiont is associated with beetles of the family <i>Silvanidae</i>.
