

Genus *Candidatus Biekeibacterium*

Etymology

[Bie.ke.i.bac.te'ri.um] *Bieke*, the original name given to the Island Municipality of Vieques by the indigenous people from Puerto Rico, Taínos. *Bieke* also means small island and Vieques is the Spanish given and written name after colonization; N.L. neut. n. *bacterium*, a small rod; N.L. neut. n. *Biekeibacterium*, a small rod from *Bieke*

Nomenclatural type

Species *Candidatus Biekeibacterium resiliens*

Description

Non-photosynthetic, non-nitrogen fixer, non-spore-forming organisms often found in contaminated natural environments by organic pollutants.
