

## Family *Abzuiibacteriaceae*

### Etymology

[Ab.zu.i.i.bac.te.ri.a'ce.ae] N.L. neut. n. *Abzuiibacterium*, referring to the type genus *Abzuiibacterium*; *-aceae*, ending to denote a family; N.L. fem. pl. n. *Abzuiibacteriaceae*, the *Abzuiibacterium* family

### Nomenclatural type

Genus *Abzuiibacterium*

### Description

This family belongs to the order *Omnitrophales*, in the class *Omnitrophia*, phylum *Omnitrophota*. The description of this monotypic family is currently the same as the genus *Abzuiibacterium*. The nomenclatural type of the family is the genus *Abzuiibacterium*.
