

Genus *Abzuiibacterium*

Etymology

[Ab.zu.i.i.bac.te'ri.um] N.L. n. *Abzu*, the Mesopotamian god of fresh water; L. neut. n. *bacterium*, a bacterium; N.L. neut. n. *Abzuiibacterium*, a bacterium named after the Mesopotamian god of fresh water, Abzu

Nomenclatural type

Species *Abzuiibacterium crystallinum*^{Ts}

Description

This monotypic genus belongs to the family *Abzuiibacteriaceae*, order *Omnitrophales*, class *Omnitrophia*, phylum *Omnitrophota*. The description of this monotypic genus is currently the same as that of the species *Abzuiibacterium crystallinum*, the type species for the genus.
