

## Genus *Danuiimicrobium*

### Etymology

[Da.nu.i.i.mi.cro'bi.um] N.L. n. *Danu*, Hindu goddess of primordial waters; L. neut. n. *microbium*, a microbe; N.L. neut. n. *Danuiimicrobium*, a microbe named after the Hindu goddess of primordial water, Danu

### Nomenclatural type

Species *Danuiimicrobium aquiferis*<sup>Ts</sup>

### Description

This genus belongs to the family *Danuiimicrobiaceae*, in the order *Omnitrophales*, class *Omnitrophia*, phylum *Omnitrophota*. As a monotypic genus, the description is currently the same as for the type species of the genus, *Danuiimicrobium aquiferis*.
