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### Etymology

[Ka.pa.i.bac.te'ri.um] *Kapa*, based on Motse Kapa, the name of Cape Town in the Sesotho language; N.L. neut. n. *bacterium*, a rod; N.L. neut. n. *Kapaibacterium*, a rod from Cape Town
