

## Genus *Methanoliparum*

---

### Etymology

[Me.tha.no.li.pa'rum] N.L. **pref.** *methano-*, pertaining to methane; **Gr. adj.** *liparos*, fat, greasy; **N.L. neut. n.** *Methanoliparum*, methane-producing/consuming organism present in oil-rich environments

### Nomenclatural type

Species *Methanoliparum thermophilum*<sup>Ts</sup>

### Description

Analyses of enrichment cultures indicate that members of this genus can utilize long-chain alkanes as substrate for methanogenesis.
