### Etymology

[syd.ne.y.en'sis] N.L. masc. adj. *sydneyensis*, detected in a marine sponge collected in Sydney, NSW, Australia

### Nomenclatural type

### Description

MAG detected in a metagenome from a marine sponge collected near Sydney, NSW, Australia. The genus is named after the Oceanid Perse (Greek mythology) and species is named after the collection location.
