

Genus *Tantalella*

Etymology

[Tan.ta'lel.la] N.L. fem. dim. n. *Tantalella*, Named for Tantalus (Gr. Tantalos), in Greek mythology, a mythical denizen of the underworld, condemned to being immersed in a lake.

Nomenclatural type

Species *Tantalella remota*^{T5}

Description

The genus belongs to the family *Tantalellaceae*, order *Tantalellales*, class *Gorgyriaia*, phylum *Omnitrophota*. The description is currently the same as for the nomenclatural type of the genus, the species *Tantalella remota*.
