

## Order *Nitrospinales*

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### Etymology

[Ni.tro.spi.na'les] N.L. fem. n. *Nitrospina*, type genus of the order; *-ales*, suffix to denote an order; N.L. fem. pl. n. *Nitrospinales*, the order of the genus *Nitrospina*

### Nomenclatural type

Genus *Nitrospina*

### Description

[Göker, 2022](#): Based on '*Nitrospinales*' [Lücker et al., 2013](#). The description is identical to the one given for *Nitrospinaceae* Garrity et al. 2006 ([Kuever et al., 2005](#)).

Garrity et al. 2006 (In [Kuever et al., 2005](#)): The family Nitrospinaceae was circumscribed for this volume on the basis of phylogenetic analysis of 16S rRNA sequences; the family contains the genus *Nitrospina* (type genus). Description is the same as for the genus *Nitrospina*.
