Etymology

[Ma.rī.sa.li.mo'nas] L. neut. n. *mare*, the sea; L. masc. n. *sal*, salt; N.L. fem. n. *monas*, a unit; N.L. fem. n. *Marisalimonas*, a microbe occurring in saline conditions in the sea

Nomenclatural type

Species *Marisalimonas marina*^{Ts}

Description

The former name for this genus is AAA536-G10. The description is identical to that of the type species.
