It has a versatile metabolism, with the capacity to metabolize various sugars and assimilate minerals like nitrate and sulfate. Its genome is robust, consisting of 16 contigs with about 3,315 predicted genes. Additionally, it demonstrates potential as a biocontrol agent, given its ability to antagonize certain pathogens.
